Such move-up entries shall be accepted subject to the availability of the class and payment of any difference in the entry fee.

Move ups for Friday, October 8th must be received no later than 6:00 pm Monday, October 3rd. Move ups for October 9th & 10th will be accepted the day prior until the last ribbons are awarded.

JUMP HEIGHT POLICY: When filling out an entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the trial secretary knows whether to include your dog on the Dogs to be Measured List. **It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.**

It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. Additionally, if a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running. Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 2, Section 4

HEIGHT DIVISIONS: Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division and titling class. Dogs may jump in higher height class in regular classes, dogs must jump in proper height class in preferred classes.

JUDGING TIME & COURSE FAMILIARIZATION

Judging will begin at 11 am on Friday & 9:00 am Saturday & Sunday (first dog on the line). Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. The walk through is restricted to handlers entered only in that class. The walk through period will be held prior to each class.

EQUIPMENT FAMILIARIZATION

Novice dogs and handlers will **NOT** be given a familiarization period. A warm-up area consisting of a regulation agility jump shall be provided for all exhibitors.

Awards & Prizes

A dark green qualifying ribbon will be given to each dog with a qualifying score. Rosettes will be awarded to the top four qualifiers in each height division in each class as follows:

- 1st place Blue Rosette
- 2nd place Red Rosette
- 3rd place Yellow Rosette
- 4th place White Rosette

A qualifying score is required for ALL prizes. "Dog" means either sex. New title ribbons, Double Q ribbons, PACH ribbons, MACH ribbons and MACH & PACH bars will also be awarded. Prizes must be claimed the day of the trial, none will be mailed.

CATALOGS/RUNNING ORDER SHEETS

Running order sheets will be available to all exhibitors for no charge. A limited number of catalogs will be available for purchase at the site.

Trial Site Rules

Directions to the Clubhouse

From Madison and points West: Take Hwy 12/18 East. Go south (right) on Hwy 73. Turn West (right) on Prairie Queen. Take Prairie Queen until it ends and then turn South (left) on Evergreen Drive. The club is almost immediately on your right (west side of the road).

From Janesville and points South: Take I-90 West / 39 North. Exit onto Hwy 73 North. Continue on 73 North until you reach Prairie Queen / PQ. Turn West (left) on Prairie Queen. Take Prairie Queen until it ends and then turn South (left) on Evergreen Drive. The club is almost immediately on your right (west side of the road).

From the Milwaukee area: You may either come in on Hwy 18 West or I-94 West, depending on your location. From Hwy 18, Continue West through the town of Cambridge. Go south (left) on Hwy 73. Turn West (right) on Prairie Queen. (Note: on the East side of Hwy 73, Prairie Queen turns into County Trk. PQ.) Take Prairie Queen until it ends and then turn South (left) on Evergreen Drive. The club is almost immediately on your right (west side of the road).

From I-94, exit at Hwy 73. Take Hwy. 73 South (continue past Hwy 12/18) until you reach Prairie Queen / PQ. Turn West (right) on Prairie Queen. (Note: on the East side of Hwy 73, Prairie Queen turns into County Trk. PQ.) Take Prairie Queen until it ends and then turn South (left) on Evergreen Drive. The club is almost immediately on your right (west side of the road). There is a sign out near the road.

From Cambridge: Go west on PQ / Prairie Queen and south on Evergreen Drive.

From points North: Take I-90/94 to Hwy 12 East. Go south on Hwy 73, west on Prairie Queen and south on Evergreen Drive.

Look for the sign out by the road. Please follow the directions of the parking monitor.

Trial Regulations – Notice to Exhibitors

Entries not on official AKC entry forms (5x7 size only) or photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are **not acceptable**.

Fax, telephone, email and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Mail all entries with fees to: Katrina Hughes, N7699 Cty Hwy D, Belleville, WI 53508 . Overnight mail, UPS and FedEx packages must be sent with “no signature required.” Make all checks & money orders payable to LDTC. All fees to be payable in US dollars. Do not send cash. Entries received without fees will not be accepted. Post dated and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check. A maximum of ten (10) dogs may be submitted per envelope for entries.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

If the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee, entry fees will not be refunded.

Refunds will not be given for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event a dog and /or handler are absent or are dismissed from competition regardless of the reason for such dismissal.

Entry fees for bitches that come into season or dogs that are injured after the closing date will be refunded by mail, minus \$8.00 per day fee, if a veterinarian’s certificate is presented to the trial secretary prior to the start of judging. Errors on entry form are the owner’s responsibility and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the trial has closed.

Declinations of entries: Lakeland Dog Training Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove dogs on account of disease, viciousness or other causes and no one shall not have any claim or recourse against Lakeland Dog Training Club.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having its dog ready at ringside when it is to be judged. **Dogs may arrive** any time prior to judging. **Dogs not required** for further judging will be excused.

Dogs Eligible to Enter: This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or have an AKC Limited Registration, a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number (for mixed breed dogs) or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) number. Not eligible are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog’s physical or mental performance.

Dogs and children at the trial site must be in the control of their handler or parent. Any exhibitor whose dog or child engages in unsafe or disruptive behavior may at the discretion of the trial committee be asked to leave the trial site. Puppies under six months of age are prohibited from the trial site. Pinch collars, citronella collars, electric and dummy electric collars, gentle leaders, and similar halter collars are prohibited on the trial site.

The safety of the dogs is the primary concern of Lakeland Dog Training Club. By entering this trial exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform the obstacles safely.

Lakeland Dog Training Club is not responsible for the loss of, injury to or the death of any dog exhibited or the loss of or damage to any participant whether the result of an accident or other cause.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian’s recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.
